Routes of Interest - Suresnes American Cemetery — Paris #2

Pershing-Lafayette Versailles Monument - On the way to Versailles.

The Pershing-Lafayette Versailles Monument straddles the D985 – Avenue des États-Unis and is open 24 hours a day.

- 1. Leaving the Suresnes Cemetery turn right onto Boulevard Washington (D5).
- 2. Boulevard Washington becomes Boulevard Maréchal de Lattre de Tassigny.
- 3. Proceed about one kilometer to the intersection of Rue de la Procession (D5).
- 4. Turn left.
- 5. Follow this street to into the first traffic circle.
- 6. Turn off the traffic circle right into Rue Louis Loucheur (D39), towards Boulogne /Billancourt/Saint-Cloud.
- 7. Follow this street to the intersection with Boulevard de la Republique (D985)
- 8. Turn right toward Garches/Ville D'Avray
- 9. Stay on Boulevard de la Republique (D985) until you come to a traffic circle.
- 10. Go through the circle and out the opposite side.
- 11. You are on Avenue General Leclerc (D985)
- 12. Continue straight.
- 13. You'll pass into park land and under two overpasses.
- 14. In the center of Ville D'Avray go straight across the first intersection in to the Rue De Versailles (D985).
- 15. Rue de Versailles becomes Avenue des États-Unis.
- 16. You pass out of Ville D'Avray and just before entering the town of Versailles you will find the monument. Small plazas on either side of the road with Columns bearing the names of Pershing and Lafayette.
- 17. There is street parking ahead on the right.
- 18. The site is about 3.5 Km from the Palace of Versailles.
