- 1. (By Car) From in front of the guest reception house of the ABMC site turn left and then immediately right.
- 2. At the A324 turn right
- 3. At the traffic light turn left toward Camberley on B3012.
- 4. The road will curve about a bit and pass roads coming in from the right.
- 5. You will pass a place where there are gravel parking trailheads on either side of the road.
- 6. Just after pass Keogh Close on the left.
- 7. Turn left into the military area where the road turns sharply right.
- 8. Ask Directions when you present your ID.
